Bnos Leah Prospect Park Yeshiva: Brooklyn & Monsey An Overview:

Prospect Park Yeshiva Bnos Leah was founded by Rabbi Avrohom Kelman זצ"ל to help him in his efforts to have all his shul's children enroll in yeshiva. In the early 1950's many new immigrants and Holocaust survivors didn't rate yeshiva chinuch as being worth the cost and the trouble of finding a school, or one that would accept their children.

When he arrived at the Prospect Park Jewish Center in September of 1950, the shul was in a second-floor room over a grocery store. Within two years he started a building drive and opened a kindergarten class and a Talmud Torah for children in public school. By 1954 the new building was completed and he opened a first grade. This was the first of his many remarkable accomplishments. Perhaps the most remarkable is the extraordinary group of mechanchos and teachers that the mosad has attracted. They are responsible for creating a school milieu that encourages student achievement.

We are grateful for the shul that founded the Yeshiva 67 years ago, and are thankful for the many years that Rabbi Avrohom Kelman זצ"ל, his son and grandchildren have been at the helm of our Yeshiva. We have also benefited from wonderful officers and legions of great students and families.

The Yeshiva's first elementary school class graduated in June of 1962, and in



September 1963 the high school was started. All classes are currently located in spacious accommodations on Avenue R. Our students and alumnae are well respected throughout the Torah world.

It is brought in the name of the Arizal that הכל הולך אחר ההתחלה (Everything follows the beginning). This is true in education as well. Our wonderful nursery and preschool, led by Mrs. Elky Federman instill in our girls a joy of learning and doing mitzvos. The foundations are laid for Hebrew language, thinking skills, and a willingness to accept classroom discipline. All of the above is accomplished with tremendous warmth.

The next division led by Mrs. Osnat Klestzick, Rabbi Leib Kelman, Rabbi Akiva Kelman, Mrs. Eva Aberbach, Mrs. Esther Salamon and Mrs. Hadassah Fruchthandler focuses on every single student to ensure their spiritual and academic growth. The elementary school builds on the preschool foundation and continues to help students acquire the skills to learn Chumash, Rashi, Navi, *dikduk*, *safa*, *historia*, *halacha* and *parsha*. The school uses our own innovative program, Penina Parsha to teach parsha mastery. *Middos tovos* are taught at every grade level along with handwriting, Hebrew language and many other components of *chinuch habanos*. The secular studies department instills a love of reading and works to make students adept at writing and mathematics and many additional subjects. Science Lab, Computer Lab, Library, Chess, Enrichment, Art, Music and Gym help round out the program in elementary school.

Our girls continue on to high school under the leadership of our world renowned principals Rabbi Stern and Mrs. Press. Content is acquired using old skills as well as newly-learned skills in high school. Students are exposed to a very broad



curriculum in both limudei kodesh and chol. Our teaching staff also works on hashkafa, middos and socialization.

We are excited about our new Coding class which was actually started at the request of a student, as well as our STEM courses taught in the high school in the tenth and twelfth grades. This curriculum is being offered by The Center for Initiatives in Jewish Education (CIJE) and is jointly funded by CIJE and Prospect Park Yeshiva. We hope that our girls will develop new career paths suitable for frum women and mothers. Our students go on to seminaries in Eretz Yisroel and many continue their secular educations and develop careers. The Yeshiva maintains two shuls, one on Avenue R and one on Dorchester Road.

In September 2018 we started a BLOPPY branch in New City/ Monsey. We started with a Kindergarten, Pre 1A and first grade and now have a second grade. There are over 70 students and more than 50 applicants for next year. The school is led by Rebbitzin Shoshana Rube, a well-known Monsey mechaneches, and by Mrs. Shifra Miriam Goldberger, a BLOPPY Brooklyn administrator for almost 25 years. Under Rabbi Leib Kelman's and Rabbi Akiva Kelman's guidance the school has gotten off to a great start. The teachers and principal are warm and encouraging, the school has the flavor of BLOPPY Brooklyn with its own added emphasis on nurturing every student, according to her needs.

The Annual Dinner Journal Campaign is the main fund-raising event that helps to cover the Yeshiva's deficit. It is a cause worthy of your support and we extend our heartfelt thanks to all who share in making this Dinner and Journal Campaign successful. May you be rewarded.


